But what about weeks, months and years? Age is pretty simple. Man created the concept of the year because the seasons are repeated on an annual basis. The ability to predict seasons is crucial for life if you are planting crops or trying to prepare for winter. Most plants grow up and bear fruit on an annual schedule, so this is a natural growth. A year is defined as the amount of time it takes for the Earth to orbit the sun once. This takes about 365 days. If you measure the exact time it takes for the Earth to orbit the sun, the number is actually 365,242,199 days (according to the Encyclopedia Britannica). Adding one extra day to each fourth year gives us an average of 365.25 days a year, which is pretty close to the actual number. That's why we have leap years that are one day longer than normal years. To get even closer to the actual number, every 100 years is not a leap year, but every 400 years is a leap year. By putting together all these rules, you can see that a year is a leap year not only if it is diperic by 4 - it must also be diperic with 400 if it is a century-old year. So 1700, 1800 and 1900 were not leap years, but 2000 was. This brings the average length of the year to 365.2425 days, which is even closer to the actual number. The problem with the concept of the year is that it is difficult to determine the exact length of the year, unless your society has pretty good astronomers. Many of the cultures that astronomers lacked relied instead on lunar cycles. The lunar cycle lasts approximately 29.5 days (29.530588 days is the correct number), and almost anyone is easy to follow the Lunar Cycle simply by looking up at the sky
